DRAGON BONUS

Dragon Bonus® is a Baccarat side bet that pays when your hand is a natural winner, or when it wins by a large margin. Make the Dragon Bonus wager by betting in the marked area. You may bet either for the Player or Banker hand. The casino may require you to also make a standard Baccarat Wager.

You have two ways to win:

- 1) When your hand is a natural winner
- 2) When your non-natural hand wins by a least four points

The Dragon Bonus pays as follows:

**Naturals**

Natural Winners	1 to 1
Natural Ties	Push

**Non-Naturals**

Win by 9 Points	30 to 1
Win by 8 Points	10 to 1
Win by 7 Points	4 to 1
Win by 6 Points	4 to 1
Win by 5 Points	2 to 1
Win by 4 Points	2 to 1

All other outcomes result in a loss of the Dragon Bonus bet.

Select tables have an additional wager called "Optional Pairs"; bets are placed on bank, player or both. This wager wins 11 to 1 if the first two cards for the player or banker are an identical pair (e.g. Jack/Jack).

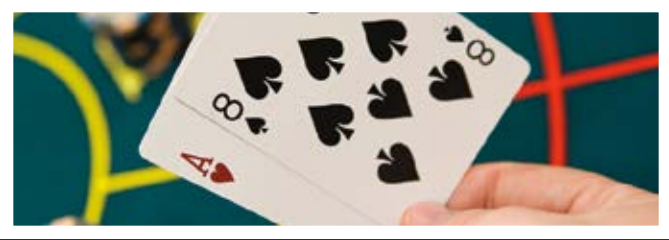

Minimums and maximums, and maximum payouts are posted at the table.

## BACCARAT

Baccarat is traditionally played on a large table usually seating 12 people. An interactive and exciting game, Baccarat has the house dealing the cards and the players turning them over.

There are smaller tables such as; Mini-Baccarat and Midi-Baccarat which seat 7 to 9 players. Depending on the game type being offered, players may not have the option to touch the cards. The drawing rules of both Mini and Midi Baccarat are the same as traditional Baccarat.

## OBJECTIVE

The object of Baccarat is to bet on which hand will have the highest value. The highest hand in Baccarat is 9 and the lowest 0. Tens, Jacks, Queens and Kings are counted as zero, an Ace counts as one, and all the other cards count as their face value. When totaling the cards on each hand, only the right-hand number of the total figure is used to determine the hand's value (as illustrated in the example).

Example:

$$7 + 8 = 15$$

$$K + 5 + 6 = 11$$

## PLAYING THE GAME

Bets are placed and then a total of four cards are dealt. The first and third are the Player's hand and the second and fourth are the Banker's hand. Once the initial cards are dealt and exposed, the Dealer announces the totals for each hand and additional cards are then drawn in accordance with the **Third Card Rules**. (A maximum of one additional card may be dealt to either hand).

You have three betting options in Baccarat. You can bet that the Player's hand will win, that the Banker's hand will win, or that both hands will tie. If you win with a bet on either the Banker's or the Player's hand; your bet will be paid at 1-to-1 odds (even money).

If you win with a bet on the Banker's hand, you will be charged a 5% commission on your winnings. If both hands tie, neither hand wins or loses, but if you have a wager on the tie, you win 8 to 1!

## THIRD CARD RULES

### When Players first two cards total:

- 0-1-2-3-4-5 • Player draws a card
- 6 - 7 • Player stands
- 8 - 9 • Natural, neither hand draws a third card

### When Banker's first two cards total:

- 0 - 1 - 2 • Banker draws unless Player shows a natural 8 or 9

### When Banker's first two cards total:

- 3 • Bank draws if Player's third card is 0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 7 - 9
- Bank stands when Player's third card is 8
- 4 • Bank draws if Player's third card is 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 - 7
- Bank stands when Player's third card is 0 - 1 - 8 - 9
- 5 • Bank draws if Player's third card is 4 - 5 - 6 - 7
- Bank stands when Player's third card is 0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 8 - 9
- 6 • Bank draws if Player's third card is 6 - 7
- Bank stands when Player's third card is 0 - 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 8 - 9
- 7 • Stands
- 8 - 9 • Natural Numbers – neither hand draws a third card



## EZ BACCARAT

EZ BACCARAT™ is played the same way as traditional baccarat. The draw rules have NOT been changed. There is no longer a 5% commission on a winning Banker wager. Instead, a winning Banker wager hand having a three card total of seven (the Dragon 7™) is a push.

## ADDITIONAL WAGERS

### DRAGON 7™ & PANDA 8™



A Banker win with a 3 card total of 7 is called a Dragon 7; and optional bets made on this winning outcome are paid 40 to 1. The Banker side is a "Push." All other bets lose.



A Player win with a 3 card total of 8 is called a Panda 8; and optional bets made on this winning outcome are paid 25 to 1. The Player side is paid even money. All other bets lose.
